To Any Police Officer of the State of Oregon:

Upon information given under oath to me by an affidavit signed and sworn to by Detective Daniel Chase of the Salem Police Department, this Court finds probable cause to believe that the items described below are presently located in the area described.

YOU ARE THEREFORE COMMANDED TO IMMEDIATELY SEIZE AND MAKE SEARCH OF:

The person of Kenneth Allen Ketchum Jr. DOB 01-08-1980, who is presently located within [REDACTED] Salem, Marion County, Oregon, or wherever he may be found. The [REDACTED] location is a two-story, single family residence located on the east side of Summer St NE adjacent to the east-west alley in the [REDACTED] St NE. The house front faces west and has a gray composition roof and blue painted siding and white trim. The front door is red in color, located on the south half of the front of the house on a raised porch landing. The prominent numerals [REDACTED] are affixed to the front of the house to the north of the front door.


TO SEARCH FOR AND TO SEIZE:

Any and all materials or evidence relevant to the crimes of Burglary 1 ORS 164.225, Criminal Trespass 1 ORS 164.255, Ex-felon in possession of a firearm ORS 166.270, Menacing ORS 163.190, Recklessly endangering another person ORS 163.195, Unlawful use of a firearm ORS 166.220, Arson 1 ORS 164.325, Arson 2 ORS 164.315, Reckless burning 193.195 and to subject those materials or evidence seized to future analysis. These materials and evidence may include, but are not limited to:

Photographs, clothing items, footwear, burglar's tools, DNA buccal swabs, firearms, firearms accessories, magazines, ammunition, holsters, storage boxes, gun locks, spent casings, fired bullets, handheld competent sources of ignition, ignitable liquids.

And you shall return to this Court within five (5) days of the date of execution a signed list of those things seized, setting forth the date and time of the search. You are further commanded to open closed containers. You are further commanded to subject substances seized to analysis.

Unless otherwise specified below, this warrant shall be executed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. within five (5) days from the date of issuance. You are further directed to make proper return of this warrant within five (5) days after execution.
